Ideas for Intercession

Questions for Prayer, Silent Reflection and Discussion

- 1. Where shall we focus our intercession today?
- 2. How has God already done in the past something like what we want to see Him do in this situation?
- 3. How do we want to invite God to fill the situation with His glory?

Activities to Facilitate Intercession

- 1. Worship Him in song. Between songs intercede, listen to God, and/or share what you think He might be saying.
- 2. Ask God which Scriptures to use to pray into the situation. Two examples:
 - a. Psalm 18. Ask God to
 - i. Teach you and those in the situation to do battle in the heavenly realms.
 - ii. Empower you do battle alongside Him.
 - iii. Bring total victory.
 - iv. Get all the glory.
 - v. Help you and those in the situation to continually praise, trust and worship Him.
 - b. 2 Chronicles 20:3-23.
 - i. Ask God to help you and those in the situation to draw near to Him.
 - ii. Affirm His nature.
 - iii. Affirm His sovereignty over all nations and declare how that is relevant to the situation about which you're praying.
 - iv. Affirm His past mighty deeds and their relevance to the situation.
 - v. Invite God to move in power.
 - vi. Confess your weakness.
 - vii. Look to him for a glorious answer.
 - viii. Respond to God with all that you are.
 - ix. Ask God to release His power through your praises.
 - x. Ask God to make your spiritual enemies destroy one another.
